

Music and Events :: Live Music Rider

New Artist - We invite all new artist that would like to be considered for booking to send an email to music@grooveground.com with links to your website, myspace page and other music links where we can find out more about you or your group. If you need to send a hardcopy, please drop off at our location in Collingswood or send to 647 Haddon Avenue, Collingswood, NJ 08108. We will send you an email to let you know we have received your package.

Returning Artist - We love to have those musicians and groups back to Grooveground that have found the coffeebar a successful venue. If you are invited back to Grooveground, ensure the Grooveground management team has updated press bio and photography for our promotional needs. Check on www.grooveground.com for any updated venue information.

Set-Times - Grooveground Coffeebar will have multiple set times throughout a given month. Our main music evening will be every Friday. These performances start at 8:30PM through 10:30PM. Grooveground also participates in town events, like Second Saturday and the Collingswood Music Festival, where musical groups are welcome.

Set-up - Grooveground Coffeebar asks that all musicians and groups be prepared to set-up their equipment at least one hour before set-time. Please notify the management team before confirming date if this will be an issue. Grooveground reserves the right to cancel the performance if not followed. Grooveground does not provide audio assistance or equipment for the performance. You must provide any PA systems, microphones or other audio equipment.

Hospitality - We are happy to provide water, hot tea and coffee to all members of the group while you are performing at Grooveground. All other specialty drinks and food items will be full price.

Capacity - We ask that all interested musicians and groups visit Grooveground Coffeebar before booking a gig. Grooveground Coffeebar is a smaller venue, good for intimate performances within the store. During warmer months, we do have outdoor performances that can accommodate larger audiences.

Promotion - Grooveground Coffeebar will promote your performance through our website, e-blast, facebook and myspace, event listing sites, in addition to other possible print promotional pieces and advertising as needed. We require that all musicians and group do their own promotions and marketing for the event. Grooveground Coffeebar does not guarantee an audience for any performance and it should be assumed that you are fully responsible for "filling the house." We require that all musician and groups provide examples and sample of any promotions you are doing. Examples include email messages, flyers and any other correspondences.

Merchandise - Grooveground Coffeebar will provide space at the night of venue to sell any merchandise you have for you and your group at no commission to Grooveground. In addition, you are welcome to sell your CD (if available) at the store for an extended period of time on consignment. We will display these CDs in a special section within the store.

Exclusivity - There are no exclusivity requirements to perform at Grooveground Coffeebar.

Deposits / Payment - No deposits or payments will be given to musicians performing at Grooveground Coffeebar. We suggest that all musicians and groups prepare a tip jar situation.

Conformity - This venue rider supersedes any other contract rider on the included issues. Any discrepancy will be resolved according to this venue rider. While every attempt is made to amend all original contracts to reflect these policies, artists and managers are encouraged to word original contracts to conform to this venue rider.

All-Age Venue - This is a family environment. Artists are reminded to refrain from obscenity or lewdness.

Other Notices - Grooveground Coffeebar cannot guarantee any equipment or services not specified on this contract. This contract is for the services of the named individual(s) within this contract. It is further agreed that: cancellation of this agreement for any reason other than an act of God, or mutual consent of both parties (artist & employer), will be considered breach of contract. Grooveground shall at all times have complete supervision, direction and control over the services of musicians/artists on this engagement. we expressly reserve the right to control the manner, means and details of the performance of services by the musicians/artists including the leader as well as the ends to be accomplished.
